- The entire month of March is dedicated to WOMEN! The 2010 theme for *National Women's History Month* is *Writing Women Back Into History*. The roots for this honor go back to March 8, 1857, when women from New York City factories staged a protest over working conditions. *International Women's Day* was first observed in 1909, but it wasn't until 1981 that Congress established *National Women's History Week* to be commemorated the second week in March. In 1987, Congress expanded the week to a month. Ever since, Congress has passed a resolution for Women's History Month, and the President has issued a proclamation. Drop by the Media Center to view some of the books about women; take a glance at some interesting facts about women; and look at this year's poster.
- Another big celebration in March is *Dr. Seuss's birthday!* If he were alive today, he would be 106 years old! A popular author for children and adults alike! How many of you know what his first book was? It took 27 rejections by different publishers before Vanguard Press published it. It is ***And to Think That I Saw It On Mulberry Street***. When he died in 1991, he had written and illustrated 44 children's books. Visit the library to look over his biography, his favorite books, and a list of his more popular titles.
